Notice to EMA coordinators assisting in the update to the Multi Hazard Mitigation Plans for Franklin, Jackson, Jefferson, Perry, and Williamson counties:

As per FEMA requirements §201.6(c)(2)(ii) §201.6(c)(3)(ii) for local mitigation plans:

All plans approved after October 1, 2008 must also address NFIP insured structures that have been repetitively damaged by floods. As well as the jurisdiction's participation in the NFIP, and continued compliance with NFIP requirements, as appropriate.

In order to comply with these requirements, Greater Egypt is requesting the following updated information for your county:

- -any county and local floodplain ordinances in effect
- -any building or subdivision requirements for floodplains
- -Flood insurance policy and claim statistics, including:
 - # of households that paid flood insurance, with total property value and total value of premiums
 - # of flood insurance claims that have been filed, with total value of payments. Preferably in numbers of closed, open, and CWOP losses
- -Number of repetitive loss properties, with number of losses per property, and total amounts paid in replacement
- -List of communities (if any) that have achieved and maintain Community Rating System Status

In addition to these requirements, we would also like to include other hazard mitigation related ordinances that may have come into effect since the last update, including but not limited to erosion control, stormwater, burning, seismic safety, other building safety standards, any zoning or compliance ordinances related to natural hazards or general safety.

Any fire station that wants to include updated Fire Insurance Ratings in the plan should also report their most recent rating
